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What is Palliative Care?

- + Specialized health care for people with a serious illness. Care is focused on providing relief from the symptoms and stress of an illness and is based on need, not prognosis.
- + This means, palliative care is available to people at all stages of their illness.
- + The goal is to provide quality-of-life to patients and their caregivers as they navigate the course of their illness, treatments, and all other steps along the way.

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How is Palliative Care Paid for?

Palliative care is covered by most insurance plans including Medicare and Medicaid. Copay and deductible may apply.



When can I start receiving Palliative care?

You are eligible to begin palliative care when you are diagnosed with a serious illness. Our staff is available to discuss our program guidelines and determine if we are the best provider to help care for you



Where do I receive care?

Palliative care is provided in your own home setting. We will come to you, providing care in the comfort and privacy of your own home.

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What Services are Provided?

Quinlan Palliative Care is a team of specialists including a Physician, Nurse Practitioner and Social Worker who will work together with your physician(s) to ensure you receive relief from distressing symptoms such as pain, shortness of breath, fatigue, loss of appetite, constipation, nausea, difficulty with sleep and more.

GOALS:

- We will assist you with communication between you and your caregivers about your goals, concerns, and treatment options
